- ☐ Established under Standards Act, Cap. 496 (July 1974)
- ☐ Under the Ministry of Investment, Trade, and Industry



Ministry of Investments, Trade and Industry State Department for Industry

KEBS Mandate: Trade Facilitation

Import Inspection




☐ Has two components:-

▶Pre-Export Verification of Conformity (PVoC)

➤ Destination Inspection (DI)

Import Inspection Regulation





PVOC (General Goods)



- ☐ Conformity assessment program applied to products at the country of supply
- □Administered by contracted inspection agents:




















Standards - Conformity assessment is based on standards and applicable regulations







☐ **Testing:** Recognized test reports considered during certification



☐ Medical equipment: accepts test reports from ISO 13485 accredited firms, IECEE CB Scheme

Certification Routes



Routes designed to provide maximum flexibility to exporters and importers during importation

Route A

- Consignment-based certification
- inspection
- Testing

Route B

- Product Registration
- One (1) Year
 Registration Validity
- Importers/Exporters of homogenous goods

Route C

- Product Licensing
- For Manufacturers
- License valid for 3 years

Compliant Goods – Certificate of Conformity (CoC) **Non-compliant Goods** – Non-Conformity Report (NCR)

Benefits of PVOC



- Blocking importation of substandard and counterfeit goods
- □ A reduction in rejected goods less destructions and reshipments.
- □ Reduced turnaround time for clearance of goods at the port of entry





- ☐Goods with CoCs, Exemptions testing/inspection not mandatory
- ☐Goods without certifications are inspected and tested before release
- ☐ Conditional release for provided in LN 78
- ☐Goods not meeting requirements are rejected

Exemptions and Waivers



- ☐ Exemptions are provided for in LN 78 (2020):
- Clause 4(1): schedule of exempted products and the documents required.
- Clause 10: gives powers to the Cabinet Secretary to exempt any product for the requirements of PVOC on advice of the NSC.
